

MIDDLE SCHOOL DISCIPLINE PROCEDURES 2010–2011

Positive Reinforcement:

*The goal is for a class to earn 200 points in each teacher's classroom.

*The students can earn up to 5 points per class period or 10 points per day in each class.

*Misbehaviors such as talking or getting out of their seat can cause students to lose their points for a day.

*The students must work together as a class.

When a group of students has earned 200 points, they will get an opportunity to choose a reward (chosen in part by the teacher!!)

Negative Behavior Consequences:

*Unfortunately, even though we use positive reinforcement, occasionally a student has to be corrected. This is our plan of consequences for misbehavior in a day:

1st offense–warning

2nd offense–time out in another class

3rd offense–1 hour detention

4th offense–referral to Mrs. Howell

Tardies:

Three tardies to class will result in a one hour detention after school. To have an excused tardy, the student must have a written pass from school personnel. NO EXCEPTIONS!!!

Dress Code Violations:

1st offense–letter sent home

2nd offense–referral to Mrs. Howell
